

## Ear Lobe Aftercare

All you need is soap and water. It doesn't get much easier than that.

I prefer a antibacterial or antimicrobial soap. No fragrance.

Now, with that being said. If you have raised your child on natural soaps, really mild soaps, or something specific, it may be best to stick with that. Please ask your piercer if you have any questions about something you intend on using.

## Daily Cleaning Regimen

Morning: Wash hands. Put a little drop of soap in the palm of clean hand. Wet the ends of a qtip and use qtip to work soap and water into a lather. More water than soap.

Use one end of qtip to lather up front and

back of one ear, use the other end of the qtip to lather up front and back of the other ear.

Dispose of the soapy qtip and get another clean one. Wet both ends. Use one end of the qtip to rinse front and back of one ear. Use the other end of the qtip to rinse front and back of the other ear.

You may need to cup water to the ear or splash rinse. Regardless, it is important to get the soap rinsed off really well.

Evening: Wash hands. Put a little drop of soap in the palm of clean hand. Wet the ends of a qtip and use qtip to work soap and water into a lather. More water than soap.

Use one end of qtip to lather up front and back of one ear, use the other end of the qtip to lather up front and back of the other ear.

Dispose of the soapy qtip and get another

clean one. Wet both ends. Use one end of the qtip to rinse front and back of one ear. Use the other end of the qtip to rinse front and back of the other ear.

You may need to cup water to the ear or splash rinse. Regardless, it is important to get the soap rinsed off really well.

Do not rotate, turn or spin the jewelry. This only aggitates the piercing and gives more chances to get them infected.

Keep up aftercare Regimen for 6 - 8 weeks. No jewelry changes before 6 - 8 weeks. I would push for 8 weeks on both.

If you change earrings at 8 weeks. I would still do a quick change and not leave them out long. They may not be 100% healed.
